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The centre currently offers a Btec level 2 Diploma in Performing Arts.

There is a clear, effective, approach to the quality monitoring process which works well.

Policies are communicated to the small team of staff and learners, including appeals and collusion. These are formalised in a Btec file.

It is recommended that the learners should be given their own handbook to reinforce Policies and procedures.

Due to the nature of this provision, staff are also registered chaperones, they are CRB and Education authority checked and licensing is in place to allow children to perform in the evening.

There are procedures in place which ensure the programme runs smoothly. The QN has made great progress in putting clear easily understandable systems in place. Staff have attended Btec Training.

Programmes are well organised and high quality learner engagement is an underlying theme.

The company is a financial concern and have received accolades from The Welsh Assembly for their provision.

Team work was evident and the programme appears to be well managed and staff are keen to constantly improve the quality of the programme and the learner experience. The QN and lead teacher were able to show evidence of high quality feedback offered to the learners which will surely encourage and develop the young artists.

Staff have recently attended Btec training in order to deliver the programme. Industry knowledge is ongoing industry since Bitesize is a professional theatre company who only employ professional actors.

The centre has excellent facilities and there are sufficient IT resources available on site and within easy use of the learners. The Theatre has recently invested in WIFI as some learners prefer to bring their own lap tops. The theatre offers a wide range of enrichment opportunities. Theatre visits have included Theatre Clwyd to see Guys and Dolls, Chester Forum theatre to see Little Shop of Horrors and Les Miserables , Oklahoma at Llandudno and Annie and Spamalot at Stoke. Excellent.

Learners are encouraged to work towards higher grades.
